By registering for a guaranteed Mountain Rescue England and Wales charity place in the 2019 Virgin Money London Marathon, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

Registration

- Please understand the event organiser has terms and conditions that you will need to agree to upon registration. It is your responsibility to check that you are above the minimum age (as specified by the race organiser) as well as being fit to participate.
- If you are successful in securing a place through the application process the registration fee of £100 is non-refundable and this must be paid within 10 days of accepting your place.
- You acknowledge the registration fee you have paid is non-refundable and cannot be used towards your sponsorship pledge.
- You will take responsibility for registering your contact details with the third party event organiser if required. Failure to do so will mean you cannot take part in the event. If this is necessary, we will inform you well in advance of what action is required.

Contact

- You acknowledge that you will be contacted by email, phone, SMS and post in relation to the specific event you have registered for, ensuring Mountain Rescue England and Wales can deliver the necessary administration and communication required to complete your successful participation in the event.

Participation

- You acknowledge this is a fundraising event and commit to raise the minimum sponsorship pledge of £2,000, excluding any Gift Aid or employer match giving.
- You must also agree to pay the minimum of £2,000 (excluding Gift Aid) no later than six weeks post the event date. By accepting this place, you understand that Mountain Rescue England and Wales has the right to withdraw your place at any time with due warning, if they consider that you are not committed to raising the pledged sponsorship.
- You acknowledge that any travel costs relating to the event are your own responsibility, and that Mountain Rescue England and Wales will NOT cover these expenses

Donations and payments

- You will regularly pay all money collected on behalf of Mountain Rescue England and Wales to Mountain Rescue England and Wales by the following means:
- Paying online via credit or debit card
- Using a fundraising website such as justgiving.com or virginmoneygiving.com
- Sending any cheques with an enclosing letter clearly stating 'London Marathon 2019' plus your full name, address and supporter reference number to: The Treasurer, Mountain Rescue England and Wales, 12 Edward VII Avenue, Newport NP20 4NF.

Cheques should be made payable to 'Mountain Rescue England and Wales'.

Please note:

- If the sum of £1,950 has not been paid by 28 May 2019, you must agree to pay the remainder from your own personal funds within one month of this date or in instalments to be agreed in writing with Mountain Rescue England and Wales.
- We reserve the right to terminate your place in the marathon if we do not see evidence of fundraising and/or you do not meet the above targets without a valid reason.

Fundraising

- When fundraising, you will act lawfully. You must make it clear you are fundraising *in aid of* Mountain Rescue England and Wales' and are not representing *on behalf of* Mountain Rescue England and Wales. You must not do anything that may harm the reputation of Mountain Rescue England and Wales or act in a manner contrary to our values.
- You must not use the Mountain Rescue England and Wales logo without permission and must obtain all fundraising materials directly from Mountain Rescue England and Wales.
- Your fundraising will not include:
 - Raising funds by carrying out door-to-door or unsolicited collections
 - Collecting in any public place without first obtaining authorisation from the local authority and any other legally required licences or consent
 - Collecting on private property (including shops, pubs etc) without first obtaining permission of the owner of the private property
 - Conducting a raffle or lottery or putting on a public event without first contacting Mountain Rescue England and Wales and taking any steps for which Mountain Rescue England and Wales requires (private/work lotteries and private events are exempt from regulation)

Withdrawing from the event

- If you have to withdraw prior to the event, you must notify Mountain Rescue England and Wales immediately and before the registration deadline if possible so we can reallocate your place to someone else. Any money raised to the date of withdrawal will be retained as a donation towards Mountain Rescue England and Wales.
- If you wish to refund your donors in this instance, you must ask your individual donors to make a written request to Mountain Rescue England and Wales, as they will be refunded directly.
