INCIDENT REPORT 1996

This year's incidents and accidents in England and Wales are summarized as follows:-

All clinical diagnoses and causes of incidents are those made on the spot; not all incidents have follow up reports from a Coroners Court or hospital.


There has been another welcome reduction in the number of reported fatalities. The incidence of climbing deaths is down to four from the previous year's total of six. At 19, the fatalities amongst fell walkers is down from the previous year's figure of 27; medical collapses, probably heart attacks, accounted for 9 and mishap the remaining 10. There were 2 drownings, one of whom was a diver.

The other sports activities produced 68 incidents, an increase of 24 on last year, and almost at the 1994 level.

The category of "Consultancy" was instigated last year. There were 23 such incidents in this category and these are included in the total number of incidents.

This year, there were 209 calls representing more than 27250 man-hours for Mountain Rescue Personnel to assist the Police and Ambulance services with non-mountain incidents. This represents an increase of 45% and 9% respectively. It should be noted that three searches alone consumed 12,310 man-hours, and during two periods of severe winter weather, 4,040 man-hours were given in providing assistance to the local ambulance service. In total, in the non-mountain category, there were, unfortunately, 21 fatalities.

Finally, 32 sheep, 9 dogs and a cow were rescued for local residents.
